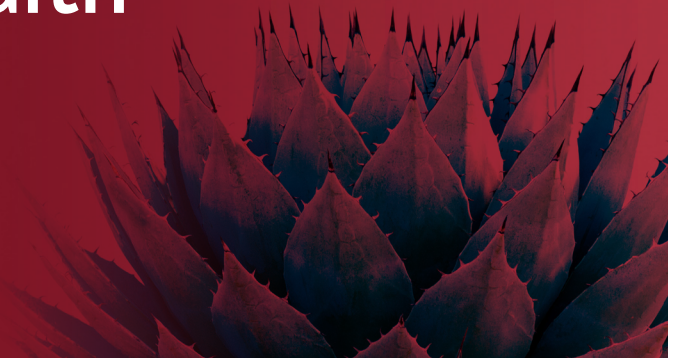

## ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Refugee Mental Health Program Clinician is responsible for providing clinical behavioral health services and care coordination for newcomer asylum-seekers and refugees.

- Provide outpatient individual (youth and adults), couples, and group psychotherapy using a trauma-informed lens.
- Assess clients' functioning based on review of client information, interviews, observation, tests, and collaboration with other staff members.
- Develop and implement treatment plans based on assessment, clinical experience, and knowledge.
- Respond to client crisis utilizing clinician on-call protocol.
- Collaborate and coordinate care with case managers.
- Ensures timely and accurate reporting in the Electronic Medical Record, Time and Effort logs and other program charts as required by Centro Sávila.
- Supervises non-independently licensed clinicians and/or graduate students.
- Actively participate in staffings, reporting meetings, trainings, and individual and group supervision at Centro Sávila.
- Actively participate in community outreach and meetings as related to case work, advocacy, and/or program implementation, as approved by Clinical Supervisor.
- Promotes excellent customer service systems, positive outcomes and participates in service evaluation.
- Other duties as required.

## QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Understanding of social determinants of health as they relate to healthcare and case management integration in behavioral health services.
- Understanding of the economic, political and social factors that contribute to the need for people to immigrate to the US as refugees and asylees.
- Understand of political violence/trauma and how it impacts newcomer health.
- Experience working with at-risk immigrant, refugee populations and crime victims.
- Minimum 2 years experience in delivery of psychotherapeutic services to youth and adults.
- Understanding of social determinants of health and case management integration in behavioral health services.
- Strengths-based, client-centered, trauma-informed approach to services.
- Maintain professional licensure and/or certification throughout employment.
- Clear understanding of confidentiality and strong sense of ethics and professionalism.
- Provide a non-judgmental and supportive environment to vulnerable clients.
- Seek guidance from supervisor, as needed.
- Excellent time management skills and ability to multi-task and prioritize work.
- Attention to detail and problem-solving skills.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Strong organizational and planning skills.
- Commitment to ongoing professional growth.
- Ability to work as a team member.

- Independent LPCC, LCSW/LISW, Licensed Art Therapist, or LMFT required and active license in the State of New Mexico.
- Ability to communicate fluently in both Spanish and English in written and verbal communications.
- Strong Somatic Psychotherapy Understanding.
- Experience working with at-risk immigrant populations.
- Experience working with crime victims.
- Network effectively with other agencies and professionals within the service area.
